



Notice of Race

2010 Quebec Dinghy Championships

September 11-12, 2010, Royal St. Lawrence Yacht Club



1. ORGANISATION

The races will be held on Lake Saint Louis, Dorval, Quebec. The event is organised by the Royal St. Lawrence Yacht Club and is sanctioned by the Quebec Sailing Federation.

2. RULES

Racing during this event will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association, the class rules (except as modified by this Notice of Race) and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of conflict in translation, the English version will prevail.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

The Quebec Championships is open to members of the classes and categories listed in section 4. Competitors must register at the Royal St. Lawrence Yacht Club by the deadline in the schedule below. Registrations will be accepted in advance by completing the registration form and sending it to:

All competitors must have proof of age, proof of membership in a recognised yacht club and sign a disclaimer of responsibility (signed by a parent if less than 18 years of age)

4. CLASSES AND CATEGORIES

Classes having 5 or more participants will have a separate start.

There will be no warning signal after 1400 hours Sunday.

6. SCORING

The low point scoring system as described in Appendix A of the RRS, will be in effect. There will be a maximum of 7 races. One race is required to constitute as series.

7. REGISTRATION FEE

There is a registration fee of \$65 for each participant. **If the registration and fee are received by RStLYC after September 6, 2010, the fee will be \$85.** The fee includes racing Saturday and Sunday, two lunches, dinner and a regatta souvenir.

8. COACHES

Coaches must register. Coaches are to monitor the VHF security channel, be ready to assist in case of emergency and attend the coaches' meeting each morning. There is no coach fee. Lunches and dinner are available for a fee of \$20.

9. PRIZES

The first three places and the top female skipper in each of the categories listed in Section 4 will receive a prize.

10. ACCOMMODATIONS

There is no camping available at RStLYC. Information on nearby hotels is available by contacting the club.

11. CODE OF DISCIPLINE

In registering for this event, athletes and coaches agree to be bound by the CYA discipline code.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See CYA rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after, the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall have adequate third-party liability insurance.

14. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located under the clubhouse veranda.
